

USDA Regulations – Labeling:

- Product smoked, **in combination**, with both sawdust and **Condensed Natural Smoke** may be labeled “**naturally smoked**” or “**natural smoked**” or “**smoked**”.
- **Traditionally** smoked meat and poultry products can be labeled as “**naturally smoked**” or “**natural smoked**” or “**smoked**”.
- “Naturally Smoked Sugar” can be labeled as sugar.
- Products to which **Condensed Natural Smokes** have been applied topically and transformed to a gaseous state by the application of direct heat are considered “**smoked**” or identified by the wood species name followed by the word smoked i.e. “**Hickory Smoked**” or “**Applewood Smoked**”. No smoke declaration is required in ingredient declaration.
- Internal addition of **Condensed Natural Smoke** requires the addition of the phrase “**natural smoke flavoring added**” on the principal display panel.
